ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS

Our ColorJET Imprinting option is a 4-color process that can be imprinted on the front or back of any of our acrylic products.

ACCEPTABLE FILE FORMATS

All artwork submitted for imprinting must be in a vector based format & saved as an EPS, Illustrator or PDF file. All text & shapes must be converted to outlines.

FOR FULL COLOR IMAGES (SUCH AS PHOTOS):

Artwork must be supplied as a high-resolution JPG, EPS or TIFF – at least 300 dpi – **SCALED TO THE CORRECT SIZE**. Resizing of photos will not produce acceptable results. If photos are combined with other artwork in an Illustrator EPS or other file, all linked images must be sent separately as well.

FOR SPOT COLORS:

For best results, colors should be converted to CMYK or Pantones. We will match the colors as close as possible, however an exact match cannot be guaranteed. **IF WHITE IS TO BE USED, INDICATE WHAT IS TO BE WHITE; OTHERWISE IT WILL BE CLEAR.**

GRADATIONS AND FADES

Gradations from one color to another color can be imprinted, however colors can not fade out to clear due to the white backing on the imprints. This is also true for shadows.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Artwork **CANNOT** bleed off the edges of the piece. All artwork must be 1/4" in from the edges. If needed, we can provide you with an imprint template for you to place your artwork on.

Our minimum size for text is 10 pts. Line weights must be at least 1 pt. in thickness. Text and lines smaller than that may not imprint properly.

In most cases, what prints on paper will be reproduced on the acrylic. If images & artwork look "fuzzy" on paper or text is unreadable due to size or quality, the same will be true on acrylic.
